London, England

FEBRUARY 11

Begin your journey in cosmopolitan London, where you will meet fellow guests, your expert trip leaders and dedicated guest services staff for a welcome dinner. As your adventure begins, enjoy the atmosphere of one of the world's most iconic cities. We depart for Senegal in the morning.

Dakar, Senegal

FEBRUARY 12 – 13

Observe the salt harvesters of Lake Retba, Dakar's unique “Pink Lake” famous for the brilliant rose color of its waters. Explore Dakar's neighborhoods and monuments on a city tour or learn the secrets of Senegalese cuisine in a cooking class.



Take a ferry ride to the island of Gorée, which served as the largest slave-trading center on the African coast from the 15th to 19th centuries. A UNESCO World Heritage site, the island’s well-preserved houses, fortifications and squares stand as a haunting testimony to one of the greatest tragedies in human history.

Salvador, Brazil

FEBRUARY 14 – 16

Lomé, Togo

FEBRUARY 17 – 18

From Brazil, the jet delivers you to the palm-lined coast of Togo, one of Africa’s smallest nations. As you explore the museums, monuments and markets of Lomé, the lively Togolese capital, uncover the country’s rich history and local *vodun* (voodoo) traditions that run deep. Cruise across Lake Togo to explore Togoville, one of the country’s most important religious centers. Visit the town’s historic Catholic cathedral and shrines, and get a glimpse of life along the Mono River. Wander the labyrinthine Grand Market, where vendors sell everything under the sun, and peruse the animal curiosities of the Akodessawa Fetish Market, the world’s largest voodoo market. On a city tour of Lomé, trace Togo’s long and rich history at the Independence Monument and the National Museum, which houses an extensive collection of West African art and cultural artifacts.

ACCOMMODATIONS

A heritage landmark in downtown Lomé, the luxurious **Hôtel 2 Février** is situated near Independence Square. Sleek, comfortable rooms and suites offer exceptional views of the city and Gulf of Guinea. AlUla, Saudi Arabia

FEBRUARY 19 – 21

One of the oldest settlements on the Arabian Peninsula, AlUla was once a bustling outpost along the incense and spice routes that stretched to the Mediterranean. Today, this remote desert oasis is an open-air museum of rock-carved cities and dramatic sandstone formations. Delve into thousands of years of largely unexplored human history as you discover the red-rock tombs of Dadan and the UNESCO World Heritage site of Hegra—an astonishing Nabatean settlement that rivals the grandeur of Petra. Explore AlUla’s Old Town, where the remnants of the original, 12th-century stone and mudbrick structures can be seen among the present-day houses, shops and squares. Survey the splendor of the night sky at Algarameel, an iconic stargazing location. Admire the aptly named Elephant Rock and the area’s other dramatic rock formations with opportunities for outdoor activities.

ACCOMMODATIONS

One of the newest resorts in Saudi Arabia, **Habitas AlUla** seeks to redefine luxury. Designed with a focus on sustainability, the property’s stand-alone rooms and structures were 3D-printed and then crafted from laminated wood, aluminum and other planet-friendly materials. During your stay, take advantage of a wellness center offering yoga sessions and spa treatments, a pool and a restaurant serving Middle Eastern cuisine.

Tunis, Tunisia

FEBRUARY 22 – 23

Inhabited by a series of empires from the Phoenicians and Romans to the Ottomans, the history of modern-day Tunisia spans thousands of years. While exploring some of North Africa’s finest museums and impeccably preserved city centers, discover how this small country has been shaped by the intersection of different cultures over the centuries. Visit the impressive ruins of Carthage, where the ancient city’s forum, theater, baths, temples and residential structures remain. Wander the alleyways and souks of the UNESCO-listed Medina of Tunis, or opt to take a day trip to Dougga, considered to be North Africa’s finest example of a Roman small town. Trace Tunisia’s long and rich history as you study the vast collection of archaeological treasures at the Bardo National Museum. Travel along the coast to visit the picturesque town of Sidi Bou Said, known for its cobblestone streets, distinctive blue and white houses, and spectacular views of the Mediterranean Sea.

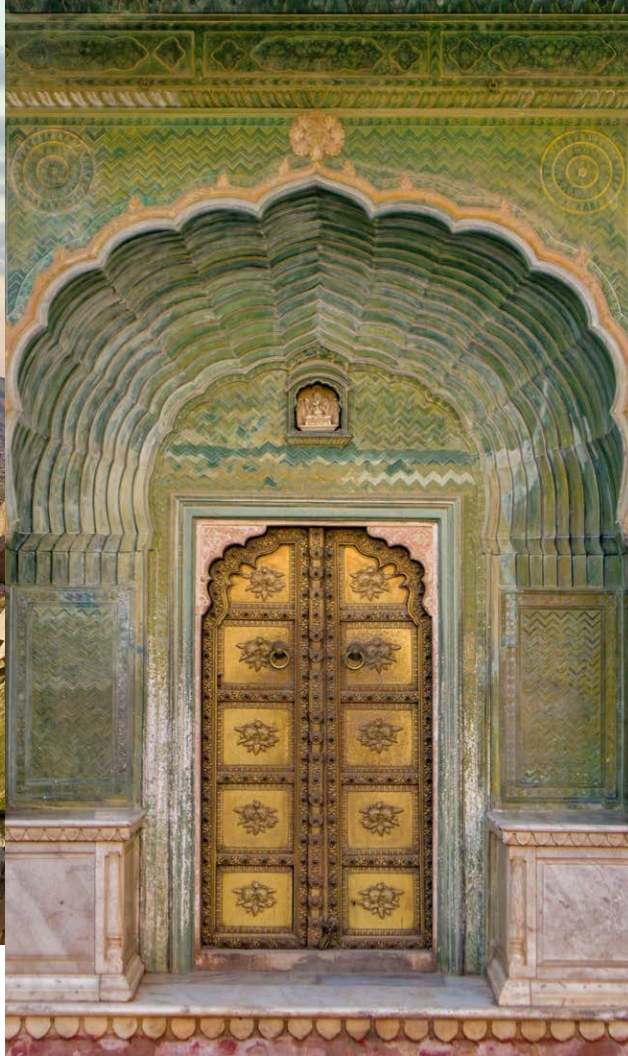

Jaipur, India

APRIL 18

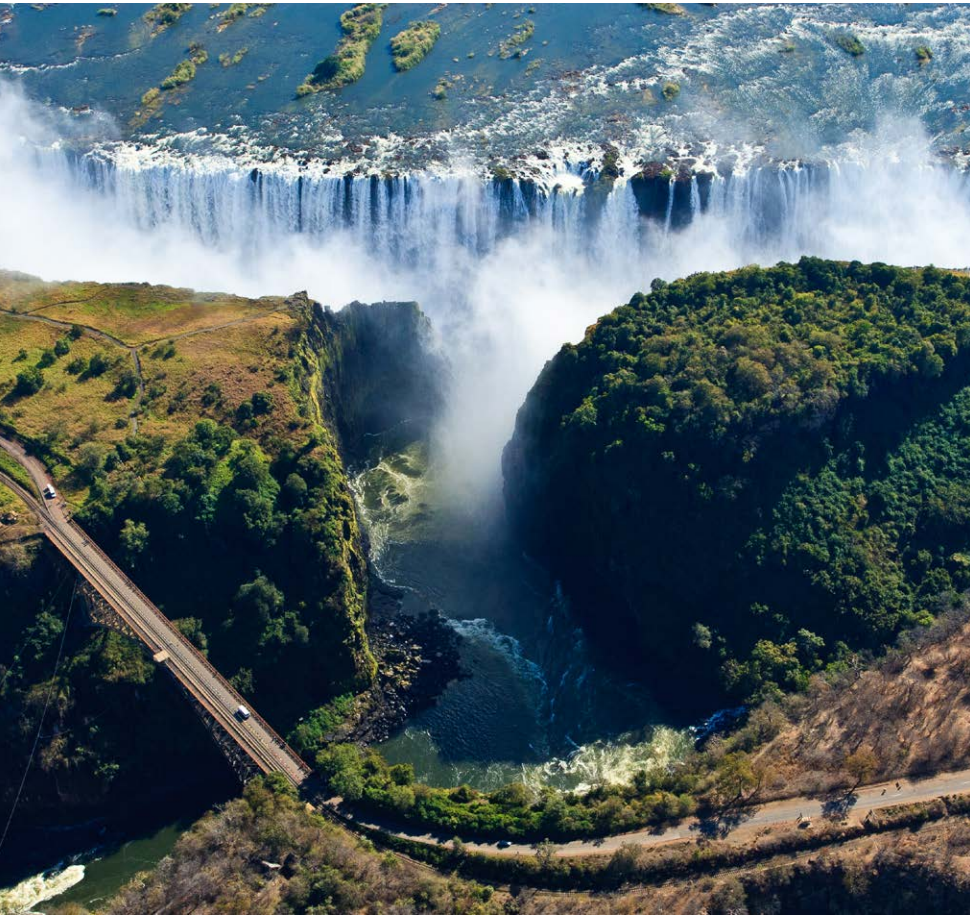

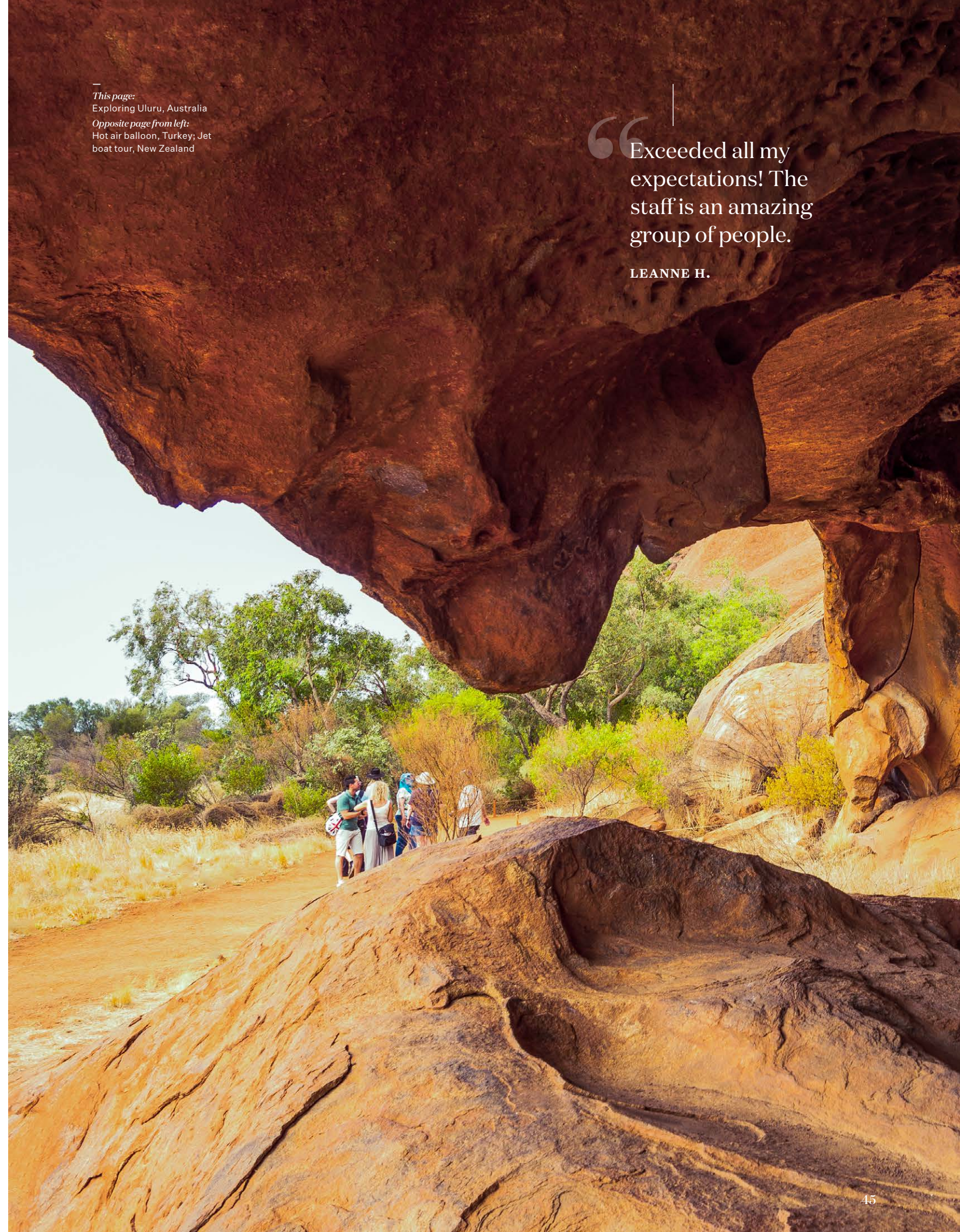
